### **Additional Information**

1. Tuition is reviewed annually each Spring and is subject to a 3% to 5% increase.
2. The university requires health insurance for all students and offers it as an option for those who need it. Please visit [Student Health](#) to see insurance rates for your age band. Dependent coverage is available.
3. Living expense estimates are based on reasonable cost-of-living analysis and do not consider existing consumer debt. A student's total financial aid offer cannot exceed the total Cost of Attendance.
4. If applicable, Federal loan fees include a 1.057% Federal Unsubsidized Loan origination fee and a 4.228% Grad PLUS Loan origination fee.
5. Beginning in Fall 2025, new Educational Leadership students seeking North Carolina Principal Licensure will be required to complete the North Carolina Principal Portfolio Assessment (NCPPEA). This assessment, administered by Pearson, is completed during the principal internship period. The NCPPEA carries a fee of \$425, which is not included in Wake Forest School of Professional Studies tuition.

### **Adjustments to Cost of Attendance**

In limited circumstances, the School of Professional Studies (SPS), Office of Financial Aid & Student Accounts may approve an increase to the Cost of Attendance (COA). Expenses that may be approved include dependent care expenses, unexpected medical bills, disability-related expenses, and one-time computer purchases. All requests are reviewed on a case-by-case basis, and documentation is required.
